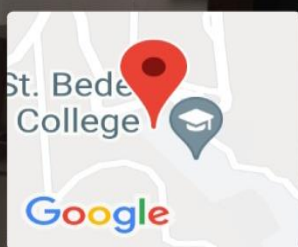
AIDS Day Celebration
