JALLIANWALA BAGH MASSACRE

On April 13, 2022, the NCC Cadets of the college under 7HP (I) Coy, NCC Shimla paid homage to the martys of Jallianwala Bagh Massacre who lost their lives on this day, 103 years ago. The cadets participated in a Poster-Making competition under the theme "Azudi Ka Amrit Mahotsav", in order to pay respect to those who lost their lives on April 13, 1919. The judge for the event was Ms. Pumam Chauthan, Assistant Professor Department of History, St. Bede's College, Shimla. She adjudged the paintings on the basis of creativity, relevance to the theme and artistic skills. Cadet Nandini Sharma was awarded the first position followed by Cadet Aishna Rahi and Cadet Anika stood second. To promulgate this on a larger platform a collage of all the poster entries was shared on the Instagram Page and the YouTube Channel of the NCC.
